



Welcome to Seattle!



We're thrilled for you to join us for the fourth annual Seattle Pride Classic 2024. This is your guide to help you navigate from Seattle-Tacoma (Sea-Tac) Airport to Northgate Station – your gateway to **Kraken Community Iceplex** and our Host Hotel, **Hampton Inn & Suites Seattle/Northgate**.

You ready? Let's do this...

<p>Once off the plane, consider hitting the restroom before the journey. (It'll take some time before your bags are ready from baggage claim, anyway).</p>	
<p>Once you are refreshed, follow signs to 'Baggage Claim'. Along your way, try and spot banks of TV monitors that display your assigned baggage carousel.</p>	
<p>If you only checked your gear bag and it hasn't dropped on the carousel, it may appear via the 'Oversized Luggage' banks.</p>	
<p>After all baggage has been retrieved (hopefully without issue), you will head up the escalator to the 'Sound Transit Link Light Rail'. Warning: It is a lengthy walk – if you need mobility assistance, there is a complimentary golf cart daily from 5 AM to 12 AM midnight.</p>	
<p>Once arrived at the Sound Transit Link Light Rail 'Sea-Tac Airport Station', you will want to purchase a ticket via the vending machine. Choose a one-way ticket to Northgate Station.</p>	
<p>Next, board the northbound 1-Line to Northgate Station. (Don't board the southbound to Angle Lake Station!)</p>	
<p>The train will travel 16 stops – roughly 50 minutes – arriving at the 17th stop for Northgate Station (which happens to be the final/last stop – so you won't miss it!). The stations are also announced audibly overhead.</p>	
<p><i>Long at last, you've made it!</i> Once you exit from the light rail train, you will be able to see Kraken Community Iceplex to your west and the host hotel to your south. Both destinations are approximately 6 – 7 minutes' walk from where you are standing.</p>
